

Learning at Home

We believe: that children learn best when they can reinforce the skills they learn at school in a range of contexts, over a period of time and independently. 'Learning at home' activities are given to support and extend children's learning. In addition, it supports children to organise their time and get used to learning at home, as they will be expected to do at secondary school.

Reading: All children are given reading books in line with their current reading ability. Sharing a reading book at least four times a week will significantly enhance the progress your child will make with their reading and in other areas. Parents/carers should write in their child's Reading Record to show they have read at home.

Spelling: Children from Y1 upwards will have a weekly spelling task to complete at home. This is set via Class Dojo and must be completed in their workbooks.

Times Tables (KS2 Yr 3-6): Times tables activities are set on Times Tables Rockstars on a weekly basis. Children have to complete tasks based on the times table they are currently learning.

Setting homework: Homework is set on a Friday and will be checked on a Friday. Children will be rewarded with Dojos for completing their homework.

Completion of homework will be acknowledged with a stamp or a sticker.
